

Steps towards a prioritised set of recommendations

- Start from GAIDv4
- The GAID provides a rigorous basis upon which to derive recommendations
- Implication is that if you want to see something in the recommendations its incumbent upon you to formulate a gap for GAIDv4!
- GAIDv4 gaps are already in a form where aspects can be lifted and placed almost directly into a recommendations document.

Balanced prioritisation

- Ensuring recommendations represent true priorities of both internal and external stakeholders shall be key
- Recommendations should cover a range of scales of work and timeframe to implementation
- Recommendations should cover a range of aspects (governance, technical, tools etc.)

Pathways to prioritisation

- Propose that initial prioritisation be quasi-objectively based upon GAIDv4 fields
 - Cost
 - Timescale
 - Impact
 - Benefits
 - Probability of delivery
 - Etc.
- Is there some magic formula we can use here? Probably not ☹️
- Important that the fields be filled properly in GAIDv4 gaps to inform this.
- Prioritisation to be nuanced by both internal and external consultation

Limited number of recommendations

- Limit the scope of the document to a set of key recommendations (ideally less than a dozen) so that it provides clear idea of priorities?
 - Implies need to amalgamate gaps if relevant to do so. Important we do this identification of synergies / dependencies and rationalisation in GAIDv4 NOW!
- Each to be formulated in such a way that they could be lifted by national, Commission or Copernicus actors and constitute a funding call
- Clear line of provenance back to the GAID basis.
